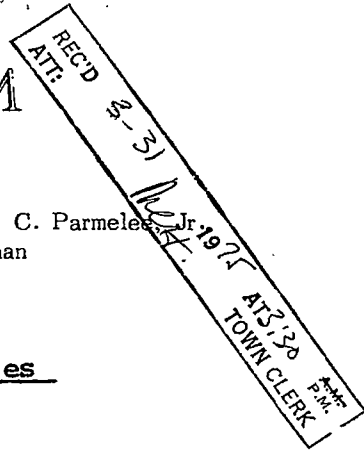
1. RESOLVED, that the First Selectman, as Chief Executive and Administrative Officer of the Town of Durham, is hereby authorized to file an application with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant in such amount as he may deem appropriate under the Community Development Block Grant Program, including all understandings and assurances contained therein; and

The First Selectman is further designated as the authorized representative of the town of Durham to act in connection with the application and is directed to provide such additional information as may be required. Vote 3-0.

2. RESOLVED, that the name of Commerce Circle be, and it hereby is, approved as a town of Durham street name in connection with a road proposed for acceptance by the town located in Stelco Industrial Park. Vote 3-0.
3. RESOLVED, that the following item be, and it hereby is, added to the call of the next scheduled Special Town Meeting:
 - To accept a road known as Commerce Circle and located in the Stelco Industrial Park as a town road.

4. RESOLVED, that a Special Town Meeting be, and it hereby is, scheduled for Monday, April 7, 1975, at 8:00 P.M. at Strong School. Vote 3-0.
5. RESOLVED, that Mrs. Merle J. Swartz be, and she hereby is, appointed to the vacant position on the Durham Recreation Committee effective immediately to serve until the expiration of the term as provided by the Articles of Authority of



the Recreation Committee. Vote 3-0.

6. RESOLVED, that the Board of Finance be, and it hereby is, requested to authorize an appropriation in the amount of \$500.00 from the Contingency Fund to pay for the insurance deductible as a result of recent damage to the Volunteer Fire Company trucks. Vote 3-0.
7. RESOLVED, that the Board of Finance be, and it hereby is, requested to authorize an appropriation in the amount of \$1,718.30 from the Revenue Sharing fund to pay for necessary repairs to the pump on the Volunteer Fire Co. 1962 Ford Fire Engine. Vote 3-0.
8. First Selectman's Report:
 - a. At the request of the First Selectman, Selectman Richard C. Parmelee will devise a plan for road and drainage improvements on Parmelee Hill, Indian Lane, and Sawmill Road to be requested from Revenue Sharing in the approximate amount of \$25,000.
 - b. The renovations and improvements to the second story of the town hall are underway and will be completed within budget.
 - c. Electric bills for street lighting in the town for February of 1975 were 30% higher for the same service than in February of 1974.
 - d. Hot asphalt plants are now open and all available personnel have been assigned to a concentrated patching program.
9. A resident appeared to request that grading of Mica Hill Road be considered for road work in the next fiscal year.
10. The following road improvement projects are considered priorities for the new fiscal year.
 - Drainage improvement and paving of a section of Maiden Lane east of Bear Rock Road.
 - Pave remaining portion of Creamery Road west of Route 77.
 - Culvert replacement on Blue Hills Road.
