The Selectmen met and paid the bills. They received a petition requesting a Town Meeting for the purpose of reverting to the 1968 Grand List. Following is the ruling from Halloran, Sage, Phelon, & Hagarty, Durham's Town Counsel; "It is our opinion that a Town Meeting cannot legally be convened for the aforesaid purpose. The town meeting, as the legislative body of the Town of Durham, has no authority, statutory or otherwise, to revert to a previous Grand List!"

The Selectmen received a letter from the Board of Finance giving approval for the additional sum of \$ 250.00 for the Board of Tax Review. The Board of Finance also has a bill for Legal Fees for \$ 1,998.40 from the Planning & Zoning Commission and they recommended that the Selectmen bring this to a Town Meeting.

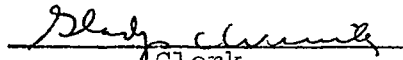
The Constable Training Session was discussed and no decision was reached.
