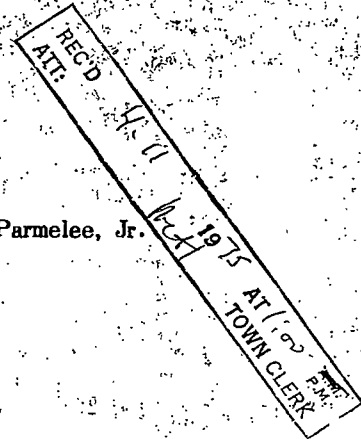

Board of Selectmen Minutes April 10, 1975

1. RESOLVED, that the following item be, and it hereby is, approved as an item for the call of the next scheduled Special Town Meeting:
- To instruct the Board of Finance to omit individual motor vehicle listings from the Town Report.
Vote 3-0.
2. The Board of Selectmen acknowledge a letter from nineteen prospective participants in the girls Little League softball program seeking a more suitable playing field. The First Selectman will investigate and respond.
3. Claim from Mrs. Vernon Stoup of Northford for \$90.00 damages to her automobile from road oil denied. Vote 3-0.
4. RESOLVED, that the recommendation of the Pay Scale Study with respect to overtime provisions to be allowed to the salaried Highway Department be, and it hereby is, approved provided, however, that any such overtime be paid only in connection with emergency overtime specifically authorized by the First Selectman, said action effective April 14, 1975.
Vote 2-1, Parmelee dissenting.
5. RESOLVED, that the Board of Finance be, and it hereby is, requested to approve a special appropriation in the amount of \$1,950 to provide for carpeting of the second story of the town hall, said amount to be transferred to the \$1.00 budget line item "Town Hall- Furniture and Equipment" from such source as the Board of Finance shall deem appropriate. The purpose of this request is to approve both acoustics and appearance as well as to provide for significantly reduced maintenance of the flooring in the

future. The decision to request carpeting at this time is the result of a recent study indicating that the town will save 40%, approximately \$1,500, by installing the floor covering before partitions are constructed. Vote 3-0.

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
