The Epoke Company will accept return of the towed sand spreader purchased in the fall of 1972, on approval for the purchase price, <sup>plus</sup> ~~plus~~ the cost of necessary repairs.

The Quit-Claim Deed for the Knights of Pythias Building was signed.

Proposed installation of eight street lights has been found to total less than the budgeted amount, the Board will study additional needs as allowed by the approved budget item. Residents wishing to suggest locations are invited to call the Selectman's Office between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M.

A letter was received from the Inter-Local Agreement Advisory Board containing notification of the expiration of the terms of Geoffrey Colgrove and George Carr on June 30, 1973.

Carl Otte was appointed to the Mid-State Planning Commission to fill the unexpired term of Hugh Cox.

Letters will be sent from the Selectmen's Office to the Fire Co. trustees, the Fire Company, and the Planning & Zoning Commission, requesting them to name the indicated number of representatives to serve on the Committee. Names should be submitted to the office of the 1st. Selectman by May 1st.

The Board of Selectmen voted to run a test of the Slurry Seal road re-surfacing process by doing Town House Road under a bid submitted by Connecticut Slurry Seal Pavement Corp. for \$607.00.

A report was made on consultation with the State Sanitarian regarding the discharge of floor drains into the roadside drainage on Fowler Ave., and Cherry Lane. All such drains must be sealed off. Foundation drains will be allowed and under some conditions, and after receipt of further permission, - sump pumps.

Specifications have been prepared for bids on trucks, radio equipment and sanders as authorized by the Town Meeting of March 26th. Bids will be opened at the April 26th meeting of the Board of Selectmen.
