A motion was made to accept the General Electric bid for their 60 watt radio eq. at \$3749.95, and the Reo Truck bid, including body, plow hitch, 12,000 lb. axle and auxiliary 3-speed transmission at \$14,133. The sander bids to be held pending receipt of further information. The vote was 2-0.

John Borenski, EEA employee has terminated his employment with the town.

Property owners on south side of Fowler Avenue have agreed to close off the cellar drains that have been emptying into the road side ditch. Work on the Fowler Avenue and Cherry Lane drainage project will begin as soon as weather permits.

It was moved to clean all Town catch basins according to a bid from Conn. Sweeping Service for \$460.00. The vote was 2-0.

Ira Kerschner will follow up on an opportunity for the Town to acquire a motorized street sweeper.

Dr. Anderson, of the State Entomologist, has been contacted and will notify us of the Gypsy Moth and Span Worm infestations soon.

No action was taken on a proposal for liability insurance on errors and omissions, protecting the Selectmen and other elected officials against suit for liability.

No action was taken on a letter from Governor Meskill urging Communities to carry National Flood Insurance.

A letter was received from Town Engineer, Dave Mylchreest, approving in principal some form of limitation on acceptance of privately built roads to insure proper grading and seeding after the winter weather. Some form of small performance bond will be investigated.

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A special meeting for consideration of a new fee system for building permits, proposed action on status of unimproved town roads, and an ordinance governing peddlars and hawkers, will be called for Monday, April 30, 1973, at 7:30 P.M.
