

BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING
APRIL 27, 1972

The Board of Selectmen met, April 27, 1972, at 8:00 P.M., in the Town Hall.

A. Reed Hayes reported on the Gypsy Moth Spraying Program. Millane Nurseries & Tree Experts have been accepted to do our spraying. All persons signed up for this program will be contacted. Spraying will be done the third week of May.

Selectman, Hayes said the report of the Road Committee has been received, and will be published in the newspapers.

The Board of Selectmen reviewed last year's budget expenditures.

Mr. Kerschner has made a proclamation for the May 6, 1972 Clean Up Day. Two town trucks will be available for this project. Mr. Kerschner reiterated, that he is one-hundred percent in favor of this clean-up, and thinks it should be an ongoing program for the beautification of the Town.

Road signs were discussed. The signs would cost from \$7.00 to \$12.00 each. It was determined that many roads were in need of road signs. First Selectman, Kerschner suggested that local volunteer organizations be contacted to carry out this program.

Mr. Kerschner reviewed a list of names presented to him, regarding a special hearing of teacher's salaries. The Selectmen approved a letter written by Mr. Kerschner, to the Board of Education requesting a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the contract with the teachers.

The Voter Making Session, and the Board of Selectmen Meeting, scheduled for June 22, 1972 at the Town Hall, has been changed to June 20, 1972, due to Graduation Night. Notification will be made.

The Board of Selectmen, and the Recreation Committee have signed a contract with HELCO to have electricity installed at the Tennis Courts. This will be paid out of the Recreation Fund. This project will get underway shortly.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
