## MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF SELECTMEN

May 6, 1976

The Meeting was called to order at 8:06 P.M. with Carl N. Otte and Joel N. Davis present.

The Board authorized the payment of bills.

Vote 2-0

Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting was granted.

Vote 2-0

The First Selectman reported that this past week CETA representatives have interviewed many of the CETA employees and have reported that the program in the Town of Durham is being run properly. It is the feeling of the employees that the program has benefited them.

The Board of Selectmen voted to accept, with regret, the resignation of A. Reed Hayes from the Board of Selectmen, effective May 1, 1976.

Joel N. Davis nominated Joe Carney to the Board of Finance. Carl N. Otte voted no.

The Board voted to table action on the Board of Finance appointment.

The Board voted to table action on the Board of Selectmen appointment.

The Board discussed the impending resignation of David Roberts from the Inland Wetlands and Water Courses Agency, effective May 10, 1976. Said term expires January 1, 1979. Action tabled until resignation becomes effective.

The appointment of an alternate to the Planning and Zoning Commission was tabled.

The Town is eligible, again this year, for road line painting. This would be done during the months of July and August. The Board voted to officially apply and register for it to be done.

Vote 2-0

The First Selectman reported that the town has rented a loader and grader, and the town crew will begin Monday to clean the waterways on the roadsides.

He also reported that 37 of the new road signs have been stolen. Each sign costs \$18.50.

The State Traffic Commission has responded that they will be investigating the town's request to make Maple Avenue a "no-through truck" route.

The Selectmen will be investigating the probability of renting a 3-5 ton roller; said rental to be part of payment of the equipment.

The Board of Selectmen voted to recommend the proposed town bicentennial flag be presented to town meeting.
