BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING May 6, 1982

The Board of Selectmen's Meeting of May 6, 1982, was called to order at 7:35 P.M. Present: M. Foster Mather, Maryann Boord, Gregory Curtis.

The minutes of the previous meeting (April 15, 1982) were approved as typed by a 3-0 vote.

Public Session:

Mr. Henry Racki, Jr. commented on what he felt was a poor job of reconstruction of the minor league baseball field. He has offered to meet with Billy Stannard and the Board of Selectmen to present Little League's dissatisfactions with the field. Other Little League members also discussed their concerns about the job.

Jim Kowolenko expressed his displeasure with the brush and tree cutting of the town crew as it affected the roadside adjacent to his property on the corner of Laurel Terrace and Cedar Drive.

Ed Higgins urged the Board of Selectmen to consider Stu Keating, Marlene Clark or Jim Gibbons to fill the alternate vacancy on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Mark Kaplan said that the Board of Selectmen is remiss and he sees malfeasance on the part of the Board of Selectmen for the job done on the little league field.

Correspondence was read and noted.

G. Curtis suggested sending one of the "Durham" license plates to Durham, England.

The Fire Company Acknowledgement Committee was dissolved by a 3-0 vote.

It was voted to have Frank Behrens, Sr. remove and replace the two yews in front of the monument by the green by a 3-0 vote.

It was voted by a 3-0 vote to move two Proclamations, one honoring Edith White and one honoring Eugene Devaux and to have these proclamations ratified by the Town Meeting to be held May 10, 1982.

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It was voted to have the enclosure in the tax bills this year to include the recommendation suggested by Joanne Salva by a 3-0 vote. The expense will be worked out with the Board of Finance.

The meeting adjourned at 9:28 P.M.
