It was voted to send a letter to Dr. Chace to instruct Att. Sweet to start proceedings against the Cleaner's establishment according to his letter of May 2, 1966. They also agreed to ask him if he would put an article in the paper telling local residents to check their wells at least once a year for possible pollution. They discussed the letter from Mr. Thorpe and need a letter or lease or something from him, showing that he assumes responsibility for anything arising from having the bees on the White property. They did not decide anything on the Pest property. Mrs. Hull came and signed all the checks as she was going away tomorrow. Six and three quarters acres that is completed south of the School Road was voted to be turned over to the Board of Education and six acres back of the Korn School, beside the brook is to be set up for Community Recreation. Tennis courts are planned.
