Board of Selectmen's Minutes May 10, 1973

The Board acknowledges receipt of Registered Surveyor's William J. Maloney's map which determines the exact location of a portion of the town line between Durham and Guilford. First Selectman, Ira N. Kerschner will discuss the matter with the First Selectman, of Guilford and a final determination of the boundary will be made. The survey was provided by William Johnson of Johnson Construction Company at his own expense.

The Board of Selectmen has approved the following appointments to the Town Property Site Selection Committee which will locate property for the town for eventual use for a town center:

The Durham Volunteer Fire Department has not yet appointed its two members, but their appointments are expected shortly. The committee is expected to begin work immediately. Vote was 3-0, on appointments.

In order to enable residents of the town to qualify for flood insurance the town of Durham will apply for qualification under the National Flood Insurance Act 1968. Such qualification would enable private residents to obtain flood insurance from private insurance sources. The vote was 3-0.

Preliminary indications are that the town's year-old application for federal erosion funds may be granted and, if so, will help to solve the town's erosion problems on Wheeler Hill Drive.

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A letter will be sent to the Planning & Zoning Commission indicating the growing seriousness of drainage problems in the town, and urging the adoption of regulations designed to eliminate similar problems in future town development. The vote was 3-0.

A discussion pertaining to CATV licenses in the town was tabled until the next meeting.

Street lighting previously approved by the Board of Selectmen, is installed and operating. Further action by the Board of Selectmen provides for the following new street lighting in the town:

Increase lumens at the corners of Maiden Lane and Main Street and High School Road and Main Street.

Install new lights on Edwards Road, cul-de-sac, on Maiden Lane between Main Street and Newton's, on Maiden Lane near High School Road, on the corner of Old Farms Road and Howard Road, and on the corner of Cedar Drive and Ridge Road. The vote was 3-0.

The meeting adjourned at 10:20 P.M.
