Building Inspector: Mr. Bastura wishes to resign the position. He suggested Robert W. Frank of Killingworth. Mr. Frank has excellent qualifications and wishes to start at once. This will be a temporary appointment until Frank Magnotta is qualified. This may require 2 or 3 more years of study. His appointment was passed by the Board (3-0) and Mr. Frank will commence his duties on June 1, 1979, pending the resignation of Mr. Bastura.
