The Selectmen met with the Board of Finance at the Town Hall at 7:00 o'clock P.M. Then at 8:00 o'clock they met with the Recreation Committee. Their duties and activities for the coming season were discussed. A bridge for the picnic grove on the former White's property and the skating rink are the main projects for this year. The Selectmen are going to try to complete filling the property at the tennis courts as soon as possible.

Due to the resignation of Mr. Frank Davis as Dog Warden, the Selectmen appointed Mr. Douglas Driscoll of Parmelee Hill Road to take this position. Mr. J. Richard Taylor was appointed to the Durham Development Commission if this is possible because of his being our Town Auditor. This vacancy was created by the resignation of Mrs. Franklyn Arrigoni. Mr. Taylor is going to check on this and let us know.

Then Mr. Stender spoke of the need for new cemetery land and made a motion that this need be given top priority among the various things that should be considered by the Selectmen. The other Selectmen agreed and instructed the clerk to invite the members of the Cemetery Committee to their adjourned meeting which will be held on May 23, at 6:00 o'clock P.M. They will make voters from 6-8:00 o'clock and ask the Committee to come at 8:00 o'clock to the Town Hall to discuss available land.
