BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 15, 1980

The May 15, 1980, meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 7:48 p.m. by the First Selectman, M. Foster Mather; Board members present: Gregory G. Curtis, Selectman; Maryann P. Boord joined the meeting as so noted. Also present: Ralph Moeller, William Moore.

The weekly disbursement sheet was so noted. G. Curtis moved approval of the minutes of the 5/8/80 meeting; seconded by F. Mather; approved. No questions were raised about the foreman's report.

The sale of the 1970 Dodge Dart was awarded to Roy Miller for \$201.50.

A discussion of the telephone system in town hall was discussed at length and M. Boord joined the meeting. F. Mather moved to defer the tax collector's request for her own telephone line and number until such budgetary provisions are made in her budget; seconded by M. Boord; 3 ayes.

F. Mather moved the appointment of Paul Roberts to the Economic Development Commission to fill a vacancy to expire 12/31/80; seconded by G. Curtis; 3 ayes.

The First Selectman advised the board that the constables will be patrolling on the weekend due to increased complaints by townspeople. He further remarked that the end of Clark Road has been blocked off with large piles of dirt.

It was agreed to remind the Chairman of the Conservation Commission that they should renew their appointment to the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency.

G. Curtis suggested that the northerly town line sign should be replaced.

The First Selectman moved to go into Executive Session to discuss union contract; seconded by G. Curtis; approved; no votes; no guests. Executive Session and meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
