The Selectmen met at 6:00 to make voters and also held their adjourned meeting. They agreed to allow the Durham Fair Asso. to widen the road on the White Property which leads to the Fair property.

The Rod and Gun Club requests the right to build ponds, to raise their fish in, on the White Property, until such time as the Town needs the property. At this time the Selectmen would give them six months notice to get their fish re-located.

Mr. Stender made a motion that the Town House Road be closed for July 26 & 27, and that the Town Clerk's office be closed on July 26. The State Grange Fair will be held on these two days.

Mr. Stender made a motion that Mr. Fisher be allowed to pasture livestock on the Dunn Hill Reservoir Site. For this he will supply a certificate of insurance and will be liable for any damage that might occur. He is going to mow all open spaces this year and pay \$20.00, due January 1, 1970 which is for 1969. At this time the amount of rent will be reviewed.
