BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 29, 1980

The Board of Selectmen's meeting of May 29, 1980, was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by First Selectman M. Foster Mather; Board members present: Maryann P. Boord, Selectwoman; Gregory G. Curtis, Selectman. Others present: Ralph Moeller, Ona McLaughlin, Bonnie Olesen.

On a motion by G. Curtis, seconded by M. Boord, the minutes of the 5/15/80 meeting were approved as written; 3 ayes. The weekly disbursement sheet was so noted.

A bill from the Town of Middlefield for \$470.16 for labor services incurred during August 1979 was discussed. The foreman's report was so noted.

A letter from the Durham Volunteer Fire Company, Inc. dated 5/17/80 was read noting the traffic hazard at the Saw Mill Road/Route 17 intersection. Reflectors to mark the roadsides are requested.

The issue of insurance coverage was initiated by a letter from Mr. and Mrs. David Roberts notifying the Town of a proposed 5th grade picnic June 1, 1980, at the pavilion. Major events scheduled to use the green and town property are: 4-H Fair, Grange Fair, Durham Fair, Family Day, Church of the Epiphany Antique Show, Kiddie Kapers. It was decided to establish a list of specifications to be met by any group using town facilities whereby a certificate of insurance would be required. This criteria will be presented for action of the Board of Selectmen at the 6/5/80 meeting.

Letter from M. DiMella, Assistant Town Clerk, dated 5/28/80 re: Bonnie Olesen Petition was noted. The matter has been forwarded to town counsel for his opinion re appropriateness for town meeting action.

The following has been established as the summer schedule for the Board meetings: June 5, June 26, July 10, July 24, Aug. 7, Aug. 21, Sept. 4.

On a motion by F. Mather the following persons were appointed to the Building Code Board of Appeals: 1) Rolf A. Florin; term to expire 21/1/84; 2) Ronald J. Markham; term to expire 12/1/83. Motion seconded by M. Boord; approved 3 ayes. The First Selectman advised the Board that an appeal is expected to come before the appeals board.

The Board discussed the signed union contract. F. Mather advised the board of changes in the contract: 8% wages; \$5,000 group life insurance; Century 96 Contract; some terminology; CETA provisions removed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
