BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING

May 31, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 8 P.M. Present: Gregory G. Curtis, First Selectman; Lewis G. Hinman, Selectman; Betty C. Wakeman, Selectwoman; Robert Frank, Building Inspector; Janet Muraca, Bookkeeper; Ona McLaughlin, Linda Dean, William Moore, Treasurer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. 3-0
Financial Report was reviewed.

Correspondence:

a) Assessor Selection Committee Chairman, Lewis Hinman, reported that the Selection Committee has met and unanimously urge the Board of Selectmen to appoint Nicholas J. Logiodice as the new Assessor for the Town of Durham.

b) Resignation of Ronald Bastura was received and accepted with regret. The Board moved to have a letter sent to Mr. Bastura on behalf of the town, thanking him for his long and faithful service. 3-0

c) Conn. Agricultural Fair: request to use the Green on July 27, 28, 29. Also request Town House Road be closed and that Maple Ave. be one way. Dates approved and no parking on Town House Road Maple Ave. as far as Route 68 and Old Cemetery Rd. The question of one way traffic on Maple Ave. will be settled next week.

d) Board of Finance: letter from C. N. Otte suggesting the Board look into a Risk Management Program. A sum of \$500 was set aside to investigate this program.

e) George Gulielmetti: a letter stating the town knocked out two monuments on Creamery Road. He had them replaced as agreed upon with Gregory Curtis. The Board moved to pay the bill of \$35.00. 3-0

f) DMIAB: Meeting will be set up to discuss the state's report on the landfill.

Appointments:

Assessor and Recreation Committee appointments tabled until next week; Janet Muraca was officially welcomed as the new bookkeeper -- replacing Donna Campbell who resigned to take a position with the Board of Education in Portland.

CSEA complaint: a meeting will take place between all parties on June 26th at the Town Hall.

Mr. Robert Frank, our new building inspector, was introduced and an informal talk followed with an exchange of several ideas.

A letter of thanks was voted to be sent to Sara B. (Knox) Pierson for planting the window boxes outside of town hall. 3-0

A letter of thanks to the Fair Assoc for mowing the green and library grounds was so voted. 3-0

The Exchange Club of Durham has sent a check to M.C.T. to aid in the transportation of Senior and Handicapped citizens.

Highway Dept: oiling schedule was handed out. Approx. 15 mi. will be covered - the subject of safety equipment will be discussed further.

Requested by Cemetery Assoc. to establish a curfew at the cemeteries. The subject will be taken to a town meeting for approval.

Town meeting has been scheduled for June 18, 1979.
