BOARD OF SELECTMEN'S MTG.

June 1, 1978

Called to order at 8:04 P.M.

Attending - 3 Board members - Norman Robinson, Republican Candidate for 100th District Seat, Ona McLaughlin and Joseph Venuti, William Moore, Robert Reilly.

Previous minutes approved: 3-0.

Mr. Curtis welcomed Norman Robinson and wished him well in the coming campaign.

Word received of approval by D.E.P. of septic lagoon site. This is now in the hands of the Conservation Commission. Expect that the Board of Selectmen will be responsible for successful operation of said project. Various ways and means of control were discussed.

Correspondence: Complaint of Marjorie Foss, 83 Main Street, about goats and ducks kept by Thomas Ryan of 81 Main Street. Mr. Curtis will call the Ryans and try to settle the situation.

Resignation of Joseph Carney from Negotiating Team effective July 1. Resignation was accepted with regret.

Letter from George Gulielmetti about work to be done on Coginchaug River at the corner of Route #17 and Creamery Road.

Engineer Selection Committee-list was supplied for further study by Board of Selectmen: Ronald Bastura, C. James Gibbons, David Mylchreest, Robert Moore, David Bascom, Dr. Leo Willett, George Zeeb, Richard Parmelee, Robert Melvin. Committee selection will be made at the June 8th board meeting.

Auditor's Reports - moved and seconded that report be accepted. 3-0

Recreation Committee - J. Venuti said Recreation Director job will be offered to Debra Didato of Middletown. Discussion followed about charging fees for Recreation and using money for recreation expenses only. Board of Selectmen feel all monies should be channeled through

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the General Fund - a single system for all groups. Board of Selectmen will discuss with Finance Board the idea of turning fee money back to the Recreation Committee once a year.

Reappoint Equipment Study Committee to study the purchase of new town truck. Thomas Arrigoni, Ralph Vynalek, Rick Parmelee, Richard Vynalek, Charles Wimler are the committee.

Mr. Curtis reported a break-in at the home of Francis Behrens on Main Street.

Wood chips are available to townspeople at fair grounds.

Matter of complaint from Mr. Robert Smith about roaming geese owned by Mr. Ronald Miller was mentioned.

Letter to be sent to Jim Lynch and Mark Spatuzzi to thank them for a job well done on the marathon.
