The Board of Selectmen met at 9:00 A.M. at the Durham Town Hall to sign the contract with the State of Conn. to obtain State Financial Assistance in the acquisition of Reservoir Sites. At the same time Mr. Wimler reported to the Board from the Cemetery Committee, that said committee has met with Mr. Reskin concerning the property previously owned by Mrs. Anne McLaren on Route 17. The Cemetery Committee is in favor of this land. There is between twenty and thirty acres available and the price is \$1500.00 an acre. The Selectmen were also in favor of this property and instructed the clerk to send a letter to the Planning Commission asking for approval of the site and to the Board of Finance asking for approval of the purchase. A road will have to be built in to the area and it will also have to be fenced. The Selectmen were invited to attend a meeting at 10:00 A.M. at the Town Hall with the Conservation Commission concerning the tree planting along Route 17 in the center of the Town.
