The Selectmen met and paid the bills. Mr. Suchanek came and discussed the problems of his job under the State Building Code.

A letter was received from the State Highway Dept. concerning the sightline condition at the intersection of South End Ave. and Route 79.

The Durham Historical Society notified the Selectmen that Charles Stannard, Lee Seeton and Roger Newton were appointed to a committee for a July 4, 1976 celebration.

The State Tax Dept. is reimbursing the Town \$ 6,945.00 for tax revenue loss, due to tax relief for the elderly.

Road signs for various roads were discussed and the Clerk was instructed to write a letter to the State Traffic Commission.

The prices were reviewed for the Town Offices and flooring in the Town Hall and the Clerk is to inform the low bidders to start work. If possible the entire first floor will be covered.

The Selectmen discussed snow plowing for the coming winter and the equipment that will be necessary.
