Immediately following the parade there will be a ceremony at the Town Green honoring our nation's servicemen and servicewomen.

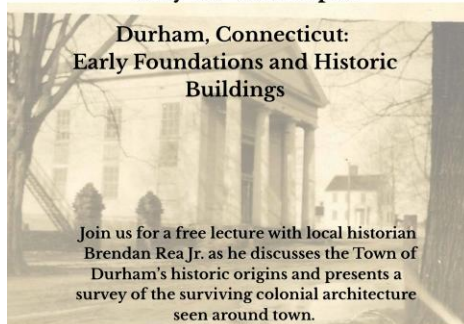
