Minutes August 20, 2025, Special Meeting

- 1. Call to Order & Roll Call: Called to order at 7:03 p.m.

- Approval of the Agenda: Moved by L. Bulion. Second by R. Anderson. Approved by all.
- **3. Public Comment (***only pertaining to agenda items***)** R. Hirsch commented on the positive work that the committee has accomplished.
- **4. Approval of July 9 minutes** Moved by L. Bulion. Second by M. Bisceglia. Approved by all.
- 5. New/Old Business
 - a. Request for Bike Safety Talk from Coginchaug Outdoor Enrichment Center: No Update
 - b. Bike Lane Celebration: L. Bulion reported that the sign-ups are available on the Town of Durham Rec Desk. There have been about 11 registrations so far. M. Bisceglia will ask the Town of Durham to send out notification through the govcast. R. Anderson will ask RSD 13 Central Office to distribute information. She will also send information to the respective chairs of the Durham Republican Town Committee and the Durham Democratic Town Committee to ask them to share information about the event with their members. L. Bulion noted the google doc that has been shared with all committee members with relevant information about the event. R. Hirsch will arrange printing of signs to be placed on the Town Green and at Strong School. R. Anderson will contact the schools and M. Bisceglia will contact Town Hall for permission. L. Bulion will bring to material to the library and R. Anderson to the Community Center.

Plan for Day: There will be two safety riders in front, two on the left-hand side, and two in the back. The state trooper will be positioned last to control traffic. M. Giardina volunteered to work at the registration

desk. One other person needed at the desk – perhaps D. Koziol or M. Giardina said his wife could assist. L. Bulion has bike safety items to be distributed when riders return from the ride: bells, safety lights, stickers, handouts on bike safety. B. Jubelirer will order and arrange for the snack items to be distributed. L. Bulion and R. Anderson will each bring beverage dispensers for water. snacks, stickers. Committee members should plan to arrive at the Community Center at 415 p.m.

- **c. Durham Night Out recap:** The group discussed the event. Only a few people stopped at the table, but all agreed that the visibility was good, and Complete Streets would want to participate next year, if possible. If participating next year, the committee will work on the activity to draw attention to the booth.
- d. Trolley Trail multiuse path update: No update.
- e. Traffic Cam Update: L. Bulion reported that the Town continues to work on this initiative. The group commented on the articles detailing the success of the cameras in Middletown. Committee will continue to follow.
- **6. Roundtable:** R. Anderson noted that walking on Maiden Lane continues to be a challenge because of the speed of vehicles on that road. L. Bulion noted plan for the Town to stripe that roadway, similar to what was done on Pickett Lane by RSD 13. L. Bulion reported that she is going to follow up with C. Janis, Boy Scout leader re their request for support on a bike rodeo.
