Minutes for May 14, 2026

1. **Call to Order & Roll Call:** Called to order at 7:06 p.m.
 - a. **Present:** R. Anderson, L. Bulion, C. O’Connell, N. Roberts
 - b. **Absent:** M. Bisceglia, M. Giardina, B. Jubelirer
2. **Approval of the Agenda:** L. Bulion moved to amend Item E under #5 from “Bike/Bus” to “General.” R. Anderson moved to accept the agenda as amended, C. O’Connell seconded. All approved.
3. Public Comment (*only pertaining to agenda items*): None.
4. **Approval of April 9 minutes:** C. O’Connell moved, N. Roberts seconded, all approved.
5. **New/Old Business**
 - a. **Traffic Cam Town Meeting April 27:** Everyone reflected positively on the essentially unanimous approval of the ordinance about the traffic cams. L. Bulion noted, and all acknowledged, that the proposals now have to go to the DOT for approval, and that this might be a lengthy process.
 - b. **Memorial Day Parade participation.** Complete Streets is marching again. L. Bulion registered the group with the parade marshal. Discussed who would be participating.
 - c. **Trolley Trail multiuse path update.** L. Bulion discussed route options and the fact that a crossing north of Valero is not safe. All agreed with her assessment that we need skilled input from a civil engineer about what is feasible and safe. L. Bulion has written to B. Rea, First Selectman, on next steps and will follow up with him.
 - d. **Bike Rack update:** L. Bulion reported that 2 bike racks are missing, presumably stolen from White’s Farm. This leaves 3 left to install. John Jenkins, Town of Durham road foreman, will install them. The Post

Office has confirmed the site location on that property. The other two are slated for the Community Center and at Allyn Brook Park, possibly near the pickle ball courts. C. O'Connell volunteered to contact the Town of Durham Recreation Director, Brian Medeiros, to find out where the racks should be placed. L. Bulion will send C. O'Connell maps and pictures to share with him.

- e. **General correspondence:** L. Bulion reported on two communications from the Complete Streets Facebook page. The first was from a father of an elementary school student expressing an interest in the "Bike Bus" bike to school program. L. Bulion communicated with him and noted that there was not enough time to plan for this year. Committee members present tonight agreed that Complete Streets should consider this for May 2027. The second message was from a Maple Avenue resident expressing concern about speeding on Maple Avenue.
- f. **Sustainable Durham:** No updates.
6. **Roundtable :** C. O'Connell commented on how Main Street crosswalks are routinely ignored by drivers and expressed her distress that it is not safe to cross Main Street. Complete Streets will continue to try to address these real concerns with the hope that future installation of speed cameras and flashing beacons might improve this situation.
