Terms and Conditions for Lottery-Awarded Deer & Turkey Hunting on Town-Owned Property for 2026 Fall/Winter Seasons

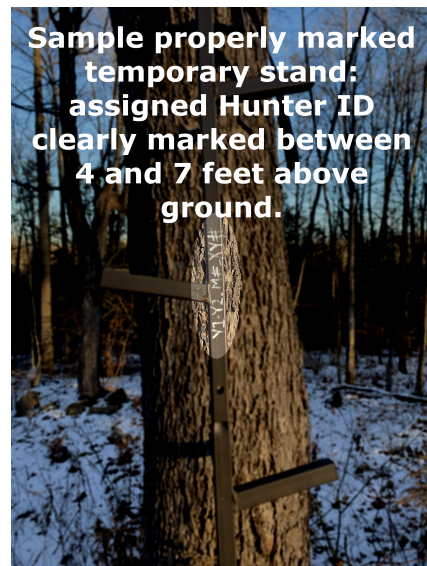
All applicable state rules and regulations must be followed at all times.

No hunting on Sundays.

Hunters must park in the areas specified on the maps available on the Town website. Hunters may not carry their weapons or other hunting apparatus across areas not designated for hunting.

Hunters must display in a manner clearly visible and legible from outside their vehicle a 3 x 5 index card with their assigned Hunter ID (also known as Durham Reference Number, which is provided to winners with the lottery award materials).

Permanent hunting blinds and stands are not permitted. Temporary blinds and stands may not be put up more than five days before the awarded hunting season. Nothing that penetrates the bark of trees is permitted. Any temporary blinds or stands must be clearly marked or tagged at a spot between 4 feet and 7 feet above ground level with the assigned Hunter ID. Any temporary blinds or stands must be removed by January 15th, those not removed are subject to a \$50 fine and ineligibility for future lotteries.



The post-season survey is required and failure to complete it fully and accurately is subject to ineligibility for future lotteries. Within four weeks (28 days) of the close of the awarded season, each hunter must complete online survey, regardless of number of days hunted and/or game harvested. (Each hunter of joint applicant duos must complete a separate survey.)

By applying to the lottery, each hunter is acknowledging the above rules.

Consent to hunt form will be delivered electronically to lottery winners.
