Fishers are a widely misunderstood native mammal. A good number of fishers from the Durham/Haddam area are being tracked as a part of an ongoing DEEP study. Come learn more about this large member of the weasel family; an alert and secretive predator of rodents, not fish. This program will be presented by CT DEEP Wildlife Biologist Paul Benjunas, and it is a joint event of the Coginchaug Outdoor Enrichment Center and Durham Recreation.

This event will be held in the cafeteria of the Durham Community Center, at 144 Pickett Lane. All ages are welcome, but we ask that those under 16 attend with a responsible adult.
