Call To Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:02pm by Chairman Seth Breakell.

Approval of the Minutes: The Commissioners received packets including the minutes from the September 3, 2025 regular meeting. In a motion made by Felix and seconded by Mike, it was voted to accept the minutes of the September 3, 2025 regular meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Fire Marshal's Report: The inspections from September 2025 were highlighted on the report presented to the Commissioners. In a motion by Mike and seconded by Felix, it was voted to accept the Fire Marshal's report of September 2025 as presented. Motion carried.

Bills: September 2025: The Commissioners reviewed the bill report and signed vouchers as presented. In a motion by Mike and seconded by Felix, it was voted to approve the bills presented. Motion carried.

Old Business: William asked about the RFP for the AC unit for the drill hall. It was posted on the Town of Goshen website on September 5 and all RFP's are due by October 7, 2025 at 4:45pm to be opened at the Selectman meeting held at 5pm on that date.

New Business: None

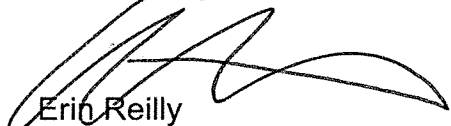
Fire Chief's Report: Barry reported that the boat is back from Florida and is at JW Tractor to have the motor put in. Other work to be completed prior to returning to service includes; drilling, alignments, the cage, and LED lights. It is anticipated to be back in service in a week to 10 days. Northeastern is bringing in an ambulance for the Commissioners, ambulance committee and Company to see which is similar to the one that will be ordered. It is a Ford F-550, gas, 4-wheel drive with a 170' box. The Capital line item was short \$17,465. Barry and Seth attended a Board of Finance meeting to request moving money to the line item to cover the deficit. After October 1st the cost would increase by 7%, a \$36K increase in cost. The company is agreeing to hold off on that increase with a signature from Barry to purchase on October 2. William asked that

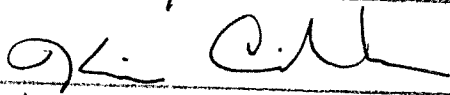

The ambulance delivery time is looking around 5 months. Barry is asking for it to be after July 1, 2026 to ensure that the monies are in the Capital.
