

**Town of Goshen-Board of Fire Commissioners
Regular Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, September 3, 2025 7:00PM**

Present: Seth Breakell, Mike Bergin(phone), and Don Sage.

Call Meeting to Order: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 7:01PM.

Approval of the Minutes: The minutes of the regular meeting of August 6, 2025 were reviewed by the Commissioners.

IN A MOTION made by Don Sage and seconded by Mike Bergin it was **VOTED** to accept the minutes from the August 6, 2025 regular meeting as written. Motion carries.

Fire Marshal's report: August, 2025 report was reviewed. Chairman Breakell requested more information on the investigation of storage tanks at 35 School Hill Road.

IN A MOTION made by Mike Bergin and seconded by Don Sage, it was **VOTED** to accept the August, 2025 Fire Marshal's report. Motion carries.

Bills: All qualifying bills & vouchers were provided by the Clerk, reviewed and signed by Commissioners.

Old Business: Clerk noted that the RFP for drill hall A/C had been resubmitted and will post on September 5, 2025.

New Business: None.

Fire Chief's Report: Chief Hall gave a report: there have been 35 (7 fire/alarms, 26 ambulance, 2 MVA) calls for the month, 7 to 8 of those were at the fair; airboat is due to be completed on September 5 and sent back; delivery of new fire truck set for December; Captain Lucas working on a way to list/sell the truck being replaced but still keep in service until new fire truck is delivered; pricing for a new ambulance is looking to be about \$375,000 and we are short approx. \$30,000; if the Fire Commission can work with the Board of Finance perhaps GFC can front the deposit/difference with a written agreement to be paid back; Sourcewell will be used to guarantee the lowest price and have it locked in; looking at a barcode system to inventory equipment and document testing which can help with future grants; looking to pay someone to make sure that the airpacks are kept charged, will check with maintenance person to see if they would like more hours.

IN A MOTION by Don Sage and seconded by Seth Breakell it was **VOTED** to accept the Chief's report for September 3, 2025. Motion carried.

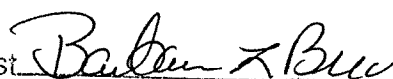
IN A MOTION by Mike Bergin and seconded by Don Sage it was **VOTED** to adjourn the meeting at 7:15pm.
