1. Call to order: Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of 10/15/2024: In a **motion** made by Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Scott Olson, it was **voted** to approve the minutes of 10/15/2024 as presented. Voted unanimous.

3. Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – October 24, 2024:

In a **motion** made by Scott Olson, seconded by Dexter S. Kinsella, it was **voted** to approve the total warrant in the amount of \$36,865.55. Payroll was in the amount of \$29,681.21 and the warrant in the amount of \$7,184.34. Voted unanimous. Included in the warrant were: Adkins Printing (election) - \$1,639.29; Driveway Refund - \$1,000.00; Valley's Cemetery (mowing) - \$1,125.00.

Approval of Payroll and Warrant – October 31, 2024:

In a **motion** made by Scott Olson, seconded by Dexter S. Kinsella, it was **voted** to approve the total warrant in the amount of \$1,342,035.25. Payroll was in the amount of \$17,745.87 and the warrant in the amount of \$1,324,289.38. Voted unanimous. Included in the warrant were: BCBS – 19,396.75; Dime Oil - \$6,790.65; Mountain Top Trucking - \$15,987.80; Region 20 - \$1,264,970.00.

Todd Carusillo announced that the City of Waterbury will be conducting inspections on Goshen roads. This is concerning the Annual Watershed Survey.
