1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, October 21, 2025:** A motion was made by Selectman Scott Olson; seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo to approve the minutes of October 21, 2025 as submitted. Voted unanimous.
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – October 30, 2025:**
In a motion made by Selectman Scott Olson, seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, it was voted to approve the total warrant in the amount of \$65,396.62. The warrant is in the amount of \$50,260.74, and Payroll is in the amount of \$15,135.88. Voted unanimous. Included in the Warrant were: Anthem/Blue Cross - \$23,979.52; Dime Oil - \$4,777.58; King & King - \$1,755.00; Pension Consultants - \$3,850.00.
4. **First Selectman's Report:**
First Selectman Todd Carusillo attended a meeting with the CFO, the Superintendent, the First Selectman's from Warren, Morris and Litchfield. The new Region 20 audit, resulted in a check in the amount of \$400,000, written payable to Litchfield School District; endorsed for payment dated 7/14/2024. Signed by Del Volpe, Ariora and Cole, Region 20 wants \$400,000.00 back from the towns. The \$118,000 debt went up to \$180,000.00 of which \$69,000 is Goshen's share. A new Agreement will be put together; Selectmen to sign accordingly.

It falsely states that the Connecticut Secretary of State is requesting social security numbers.

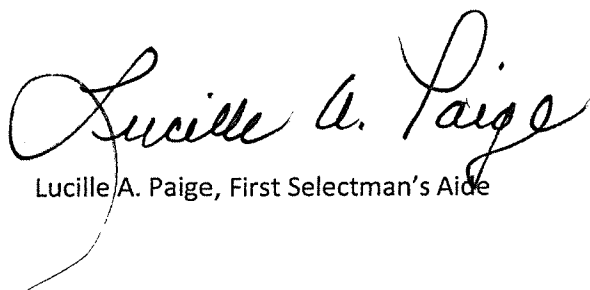
