1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, October 14, 2025:** A motion was made by Selectman Scott Olson; seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo to approve the minutes of October 14, 2025 as submitted. Voted unanimous.
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – October 23, 2025:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Scott Olson, seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, it was **voted** to approve the **total** warrant in the amount of \$55,743.99. The warrant is in the amount of \$30,397.25 and Payroll is in the amount of \$25,346.74. Voted unanimous. Included in the Warrant were: BCBS – 1,180.07; Litchfield Ford – 5,836.73; O&G – 1,186.81; MIRA \$18,762.56.
4. **First Selectman's Report:**
We have locked-in with Dime Oil Company 2026-2027: Diesel Fuel - \$2.51 gal; Heating Oil - \$2.54 gal.; Gasoline - \$2.22 gal.

Three bear complaints has been received. Caution and vigilance still must be adhered to.

Burning Permits have gone back to written applications. Please come into Town Hall, request a copy of the Burning Permit. There are three (3) copies to each individual permit. The person doing the burning must fill in the top section – name, address, signature. The clerk here completes the needed info – date, signature. White is for the office copy here; yellow is for the person doing the burning; and the pink copy is for the Fire Marshal. The First Selectman is required to personally inspect the burning site before any match is put to the burning pile.

First Selectman Todd Carusillo will be asking the Board of Finance to appropriate monies in the amount of \$1,000.00 and the First Selectman, Todd Carusillo will be applying for a **Historic Preservation** grant in the amount of \$100,000 to reconstruct the building. The Town wants to reconstruct a “post and beam” exterior structure for use as a “Farmers’ Market”, music events, etc.
