1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, October 7, 2025:** In a **motion** made by Selectman Scott Olson the minutes of *October 7, 2025* were approved – Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella “tabled” – not approved.

The warrant is in the amount of \$1,459,215.13 and Payroll is in the amount of \$18,475.37. Voted unanimous. Included in the Warrant were: Nationwide (DB pension)- \$4,923.25; Region 20 - \$1,401,151.00; State of CT Waste - \$16,953.76; USA Waste Recycling - \$10,418.08.

First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, reported that he has received information of break-ins on North Goshen Road. Locked barns and garages were broken into, etc. State Police have taken information/action regarding this issue.

Tic Tok - The incidents of a person who was urinating on public features around town (see minutes of September 16, 2025) has been solved. State Police are handling the issue – community service.
