1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, September 30, 2025:** A **motion** was made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, to table the minutes of September 30, 2025. This motion was not “seconded” at this time. Selectman Dexter Kinsella stated that those minutes had Lynette Miller saying “some of the attendees were “rude and unruly”. He feels that she had the right to make that statement. The minutes of September 23 should show that acceptance.
A **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella regarding striking the usage of “rude and unruly” should have been shown. A correction needs to show Mr. Gary Stango, Sr. was appointed to the Inland Wetlands as a member (not as chairman). The *Public Comment Section* should identify the speaker and said speaker must abide by the 2 minute rule. In addition, under “Public Comment” section, **content of each speakers’ comments need not to be recorded into the written minutes.**
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – October 9, 2025:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, it was **voted** to approve the **total** warrant in the amount of \$305,155.92. The warrant is in the amount of \$277,975.16, and Payroll is in the amount of \$27,180.76. Included in the Warrant were: Cardinal Engineering- \$15,975.00; Diamondback (boat bottom repairs – Goshen Fire Dept.) - \$11,962.00; Region 20 (re-issue) – \$159,570.07; Stryker Medical Supplies - \$6,672.88; Town of Litchfield (re-issue) – \$55,931.78 Voted unanimous.
4. **First Selectman’s Report:**
Attorney Kevin Nelligan, whose law office is located in Winsted and Canaan, has been chosen to represent the offices of the First Selectman of Goshen. Mr. Nelligan took to the podium to introduce himself and items of which Mr. Nelligan’s will be covering. Mr. Nelligan’s office will replace the law offices of Roraback & Roraback located in Torrington. A meeting of the Goshen Town Hall staff will be held with Mr. Nelligan to initiate moving forward in legal activities of a town’s municipal and legal responsibilities.

Both Warren and Morris received invoices from the Region 20 financial issue showing “interest” being charged. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo spoke with the State Dept. of Labor regarding this matter to have these “fees” waived. First Selectman Todd Carusillo will discuss further with both First Selectman from Warren and Morris going forward regarding these interest charges.
