1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, September 23, 2025:** In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Selectman, Scott Olson it was voted unanimously to accept the minutes of September 23, 2025. Selectman Dexter Kinsella stated that those minutes had Lynette Miller saying "some of the attendees were "rude and unruly". He feels that she had the right to make that statement. The minutes of September 23 should show that acceptance.
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – October 2, 2025:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, it was **voted** to approve the **total** warrant in the amount of \$262,042.72. The warrant is in the amount of \$248,459.84 and Payroll is in the amount of \$13,582.88. Included in the Warrant were VISA - \$2,023.77; Haley Ward - \$3,050.00; Regional School 20 - \$215,501.85; Sepples Tree Service - \$14,250.00. Voted unanimous.
4. **First Selectman's Report:**
Town meeting will be held. Drafts of the required ordinance have been put together. (The debt will be reduced.) Chip Roraback will write up. Invoices are paid. Chip Roraback will write the conclusive language.

Code of Conduct is currently in the hands of the Town Council. They are working with it.

DEEP is reminding people walking in the woods to wear florescent colors. This will provide some protection/warning from wandering bears during hunting season.

- 7a. **New Appointments:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Selectman Scott Olson, it was **voted** to approve *Gary Stango, Sr.* chairman of the Inland/Wetlands Commission. Voted unanimous.
8. **Other Business:**
RFP responses have been received from attorneys: Kari Olson; Kevin Mulligan; Richard Roberts; Mike & Michael Rybak. In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella; seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo. Selectman Scott Olson also added his vote for Atty. Kevin Mulligan. Voted unanimous.

9. Public Comment: (Two 2 Minutes):

Audrey Blondin is suggesting that electric charging stations (for electric cars) should be looked into. She states that a lot of grant money accompanies these electric charges. Can this be pursued?

Mr. Ross stated that everyone should be civil at these meetings wherein "politics" are the subject matter. Selectmen Scott Olson and Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella stated the protection the right of free speech has. "First Selectman, Todd Carusillo would like to limit their right. No attendees at this meeting were rude, vulgar, or unruly," Mr. Ross stated.

Lynette Miller stated she disliked the article in the local newspapers. *Goshen News* article was inaccurate. Mrs. Miller stated she will be back to continue to attack Mr. Carusillo every week until the election.

Henrietta Horvay couldn't hear the conversation at the meeting from her home computer.

Josephine Jones added that her connection kept coming in and out. She also could not connect well with those who were speaking at the meeting. Reception was poor.

10. Adjournment:
