1. **Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, August 26, 2025:** In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Selectman, Scott Olson, it was **voted** to approve the minutes of August 26, 2025. Voted unanimous.
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – 09 04, 2025:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Scott Olson, seconded by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, it was **voted** to approve the **total** warrant in the amount of \$191,135.57. The warrant is in the amount of \$175,826.81 and Payroll is in the amount of \$15,308.76. Voted unanimous. Included in the Warrant were: VISA - \$1,710.52; Eversource - \$1,621.17; King & King - \$3,773.25; Region 20 - \$162,993.00;
4. **First Selectman's Report:**
I attended the Annual Goshen Fair (all 3 days). Had a great time: I judged the Pork Cook-Off, very, very nicely done; by the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners; helped out Calvin Nodine at the Nodine's Booth; Shook hands with *so many* people.

The Lyman Lane exit seemed to go smoothly for people exiting the Fair.

I received a call this morning – residents from Westside Road and Suckerbrook would like to come in and speak about noise levels in their neighborhood. I told them they are welcome to attend a Selectmen's meeting. (motor-cross in back yard very noisy).
5. **Correspondence:**
First Selectman Todd Carusillo has rescinded the resignation of Kate Malanca (Library Aide). This is in anticipation of having a short staff in the in the Library in June.
6. **Old Business:** Members of the Planning, Conservation and Development 54 pages long

8. **Other Business:** None
9. **Public Comment (Two (2) minutes)**
Michael Leonard – Stated that Spencer Musselman (Enforcement Manager) has not gotten back to him after several attempts.

Marianne Stilson – Stated that she (and others) are having problems trying to reach Mr. Musselman. He is working with other neighboring towns. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo will make efforts to reach out to him.

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Audrey Blondin – (School Hill Road) - existing “legal” use. Abandoned. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo is also awaiting a response.

Selectman, Scott Olson - Non-conforming use on the property – oil tank? The deed shows it is conforming. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo cited the deed shows – mixed use . *Tank farm* was not mentioned on the Permit. Rebuild and add “propane” to it. Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella felt it was a contentious issue. Stiff set of regulations – permit lapsed – Inland/Wetlands.

Shilo Garceau - Knowledge of Town Planner. Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella stated she should be a part of this. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo to inquire.

10. Adjournment: In a **motion** made by Selectman, Scott Olson, seconded by Selectman, Dexter S. Kinsella, **voted** to adjourn the meeting at 5:21 p.m. Voted unanimous.
