- 1. Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- 2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, July 01, 2025:** In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Selectman, Scott Olson, it was **voted** to approve the minutes of July 01, 2025. Voted unanimous.
- 3. Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – 07-10-2025**

Tractor - \$2,850.26 and \$654.57, \$500.00; Mountain Top Trucking - \$3,656.00; Sepples Tree Service - \$4,000.00; CIRMA – \$17,587.00 and \$1,184.00.
