- 1. Call to order:** Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- 2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Tuesday, June 3, 2025, Special Meeting:** In a **motion** made by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, seconded by Selectman, Scott Olson, it was **voted** to approve the minutes of June 3, SPECIAL MEETING. Voted unanimous.
- 3. Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – June 12, 2025**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Scott Olson, seconded by First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, it was **voted** to approve the **total** warrant in the amount of \$81,525.85. The warrant is in the amount of \$52,463.53, payroll is \$29,062.32. Voted unanimous. Included in the Warrant were: Firematic – \$12,154.21; MIRA - \$15,946.63; Oddo Print Shop - \$4,859.00.

This coming Thursday, June 12, 2025 First Selectman, Todd Carusillo, will conduct his "Meet with the residents" segment, (4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.). All are welcome.

The town of Litchfield will hold a special Town Meeting on Tuesday, June 17, 2025 at the Litchfield Intermediate School regarding the "speed cameras". Litchfield has two (2) resident State Troopers. First Selectman, Todd Carusillo will attend this meeting.

A big "thank you" goes out to Steve and Julian Dresden for their donation of a desk to the Town Clerk Office; and file cabinets, along with old engineering maps (1900's) to the Goshen Public Works Dept.

Goshen's Rescue Speed Boat will go out for needed repairs. Barry Hall reported the cost will be \$10,000 repair and \$3,000 for shipping charge to repair the bottom of the boat with a special polymer finish used for airboats only for water rescue. The rescue boat is scheduled to be back here in Goshen for operation/use the second week in July - ready for summer.
- 5. Correspondence:** Milling and resurfacing will begin on Brooks Road, Deming Road, North St., Ivy Mountain Road, West Side Road. This project will begin June 23rd and is estimated to be completed July 22nd.

First Selectman, Todd Carusillo will advise as soon as he receives word.
