Present: Seth Breakell, Dexter Kinsella, and Scott Olson.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES : The minutes of March 10, 2026 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson it was VOTED to approve the regular meeting minutes from March 10, 2026 as written. Motion carries.

3. APPROVAL OF THE PAYROLL AND WARRANT - March 19, 2026:

MOTION by Scott Olson and seconded by Dexter Kinsella, it was VOTED to approve the Payroll and Warrant dated March 19, 2026 in the amount of \$26,722.06. The Warrant was in the amount of \$12,335.71 and Payroll was in the amount of \$14,386.35. Included in the Warrant were: Segalla Sand: \$4,120.92; Info Quick: \$1,482.50 . Motion carries.

4. FIRST SELECTMAN'S REPORT: Seth Breakell congratulated the Lakeview Girls Basketball team on their impressive achievement in making it to the semi-finals. He also shared that the Town has identified a potential buyer in the Dominican Republic for the old fire truck. Addressing recent complaints about dirt road conditions, he explained that the recent weather has contributed to the issues, but improvements are expected as conditions change. Additionally, Emergency Operations has been actively pursuing grant funding. The department recently secured a \$25,000 grant and is awaiting a final \$1,600 award, which would bring the total grant funding for the Emergency Operations Center to nearly \$40,000 for the current fiscal year.

5. BUDGET REVIEW: Quick review was done on the following budgets: Fire Commissioners (budget increased by \$1,156 for clerical wages.) Board of Assessment Appeals (increased by \$469 for clerical wages.) Zoning Board of Appeals (increased by \$621 for clerical wages.) Inland Wetlands Commission (increased by \$2224 for clerical wages.) Planning and Zoning (increased by \$919 for clerical wages.)

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson, it was VOTED to receive and forward the 2026-2027 budget to Board of Finance. Motion carries.

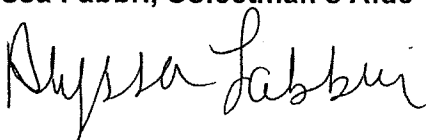

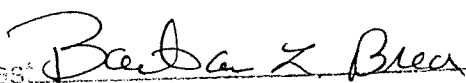
