Present: Seth Breakell, Dexter Kinsella, and Scott Olson.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:02pm.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES : The minutes of February 24, 2026 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson it was VOTED to approve the regular meeting minutes from February 24, 2026 as written. Motion carries.

3. APPROVAL OF THE PAYROLL AND WARRANT - March 5, 2026:

MOTION by Scott Olson and seconded by Dexter Kinsella, it was VOTED to approve the Payroll and Warrant dated March 5, 2026 in the amount of \$26,640.67. The Payroll was in the amount of \$20,509.53 and Warrant was in the amount of \$6,131.14. Included in the Warrant were: T-Mobile: \$304.66; Town Planner: \$1,613.20; C&M Electric: \$327.47. Motion carries.

4. FIRST SELECTMAN'S REPORT: Seth Breakell mentioned new hires Alyssa Fabbri: Selectmen's Aide, Marissa Wright: Land use enforcement (Inland/Wetlands and Planning and Zoning.) Michelle Pannullo starts Monday 3/9/26 as assistant town clerk and tax collectors clerk.

5. BUDGET REVIEW: Quick review was done on the following budgets: Conservation of Health Department (increased due to volume of "911" calling.) Newsletter (decreased by \$5,300. Intending to make changes/update to Town Topics along with Town website.) Board of Assessors (increased by \$1,200 for computer support.) Conservation Commission, Economic Development Commission: (decreased by \$53.) Tax Collector (increased by \$1,730 for computer support and continued education.) Capital Expenditures for tax assessor are \$15,000 to go against next 10 year evaluation.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson, it was VOTED to receive and forward the 2026-2027 budget for Board of Finance. Motion carries.

6. CORRESPONDENCE: No written or phone correspondence.

7. OLD BUSINESS: None.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson, it was VOTED to add engineering services for roads to new business. Motion carries.

8. NEW BUSINESS: Received 2 bids for mowing for the rec department. Knox Property Service recommended for the contract.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson, it was VOTED to agree with Erin's recommendation of Knox Property service for mowing. Motion carries.

Issue of a bid for engineering services for roads not to exceed \$12,000.

MOTION by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson, it was VOTED not to exceed \$12,000 from Town Aid Road account to professional service engineering (line item 5403). Motion carries.

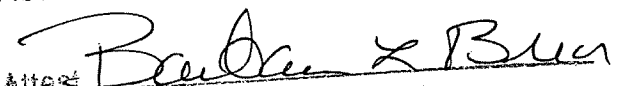
