1. **Call to order:** First Selectman, Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.
2. **Approval of the minutes of the meeting of Monday, January 13, 2026:** In a **motion** made by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, seconded by Selectman Scot Olson, it was noted that there were no errors in the minutes of January 13, 2026. Voted unanimous.
3. **Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – January 22, 2026:**
In a **motion** made by Selectman Scott Olson, seconded by Selectman Dexter S. Kinsella, it was **voted** to approve the Payroll and Warrant dated 01/22/2026 in the amount of \$133,284.94. 4. **First Selectman's Report:** First Selectman, Seth Breakell addressed the repeated snow falls experienced here in Goshen and the fine job our done by our Goshen Public Works Dept. keeping our roads open and safe for travel.
Our newly purchased fire truck is now at our firehouse. It will go onto *Firematic* to be officially equipped.

Spencer Musselman, Goshen's *Zoning Enforcement Officer*, has resigned his position. This position is in the process of finding a replacement.
