1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES : The minutes of June 16, 2026 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as written. **Motion** by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson it was **voted** to approve the regular meeting minutes from June 16, 2026 as written. Motion carries.

3. APPROVAL OF THE PAYROLL AND WARRANT - June 25, 2026: Motion by Scott Olson and seconded by Dexter Kinsella, it was **voted** to approve the Payroll and Warrant dated June 25, 2026 in the amount of \$45,635.42. 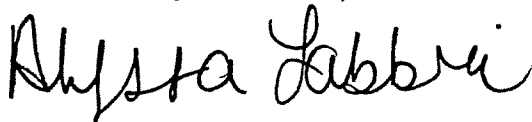
8. NEW APPOINTMENTS/ RESIGNATIONS:

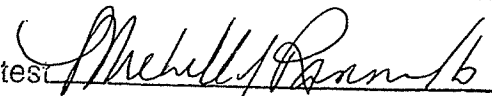
Dawn Wilkes, 123 Brynmoor Court: Extends a thank you to Public Works for repairing the large pothole on Ives Road.
