1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES : The minutes of June 9, 2026 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as written. **Motion** by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson it was **voted** to approve the regular meeting minutes from June 9, 2026 as written. Motion carries.

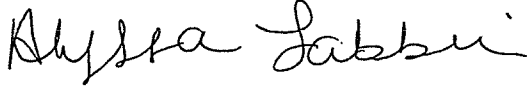

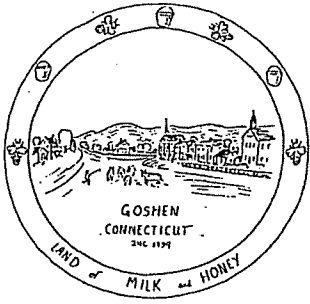
