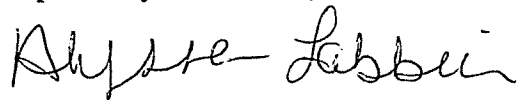

Josephine Jones, 76 East Street South: Questions noise protocols during Stampede event.

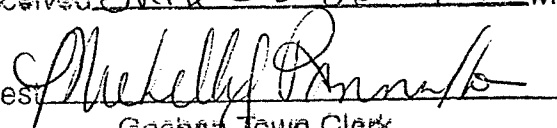

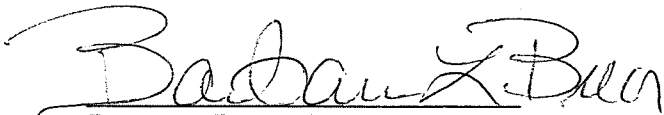
RESOLUTION
