PRESENT: Seth Breakell, Scott Olson (Zoom), and Dexter Kinsella.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Seth Breakell called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of September 1, 2026 regular meeting were reviewed. **MOTION** by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson it was **VOTED** to approve the regular meeting minutes of September 1, 2026 as written. Motion carries.

3. APPROVAL OF THE PAYROLL AND WARRANT - September 10, 2026: **MOTION** by Scott Olson and seconded by Dexter Kinsella, it was **VOTED** to approve the Payroll and Warrant dated September 10, 2026 in the amount of \$118,819.34. The Warrant was in the amount of \$88,364.77 and Payroll amount of \$30,454.57. Included in the Warrant were: Anthem Blue Cross, \$30,103.41; King & King, \$5,001.75; Sepples, \$5,775.00. Motion carries.

4. FIRST SELECTMAN'S REPORT: Teacher contracts are coming up for renewal and we are in the 3rd year of a 4 year contract. Each town will have a Selectman represent them in the negotiation meetings. The first meeting was today. Capital money was approved for new windows at Town Hall. There will be 14 windows replaced and the RFP was posted last week.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

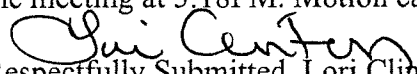
A. Lucy Hussman not available for update on RFP Revaluation Project.

Erin Reilly was thanked for her good work and 5 years of service, and wished the best. The Recreation Committee is forming a hiring committee. The Democratic Committee recommended George Kral to replace Peter Kujawski. **MOTION** by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Seth Breakell it was **VOTED** to appoint George Kral to the Goshen Housing Growth Plan Committee. There was a discussion on having a conversation first with the Committee and Commission to see if there was an alternate to move up to a regular position before appointing someone. Mr. Kinsella and Mr. Breakell did not agree and Mr. Olson would not second it and opposed. Motion carries.

9. PUBLIC COMMENT: Henrietta Horvay, 43 Brequet Road: Noted that there are 2 republican regular members and 1 republican alternate so you have minority representation on the Fire Commission of 4. She wasn't sure if the housing board needed minority representation.

10. ADJOURNMENT: **MOTION** by Dexter Kinsella and seconded by Scott Olson to adjourn the meeting at 5:18PM. Motion carries.

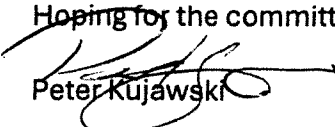
Dear Barbara, Seth and Lynette:

Lynette - thank you very much for your consideration and flexibility granted in order to work with my schedule.

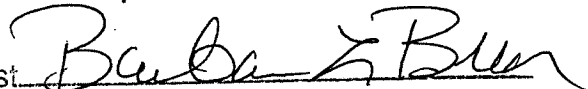
