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Meeting called to order at 7:01

Minutes of August 27, 2024. A motion to approve by Marty Harris, 2nd by Simon Ellis and approved.

Woodridge Lake: E-mail stated Hi Mark, I am away all next week and won't be able to support the meeting next week. Here is my report for Woodridge Lake.

Woodridge Lake level is down 13 inches (12 in drawdown 1 in evaporation) for dam repair. Repair going well just needs cure time. Our harvester repair is complete and is working great with control back to normal.

Eurasian watermilfoil is abundant and has good from .4 dense acres in 2023 to 4 dense acres.

We DEEP came and examined the new carp fence and now stated that the permit application is in review (another stall). Hopefully they will approve before the supply trucks stop for the season. Again, our plan is to add 440 carp to replace lost fish due to attrition.

Dog Pond: Lida Exstein reported that they hydro-raked the North end this year but contractor said that they would not come back because it is too difficult to get their equipment on the water. Needed a crane this

year. Hillory has done a survey and they are waiting results and recommendation for next year.

West Side Pond: Permit not issued this year because of a foul-up with the Fisheries Dept in DEEP. Worst case is that they may have to go thru the entire permit process again next year.

Tyler Lake: Michele Fitzpatrick stated that early treatment has moderate success. Drawn down started 9-24 and Rake the Lake is scheduled for October 5th.

All mentioned that the water level is very low this year. We have not had rain in 18 days.
