Woodridge Lake: It has been a good year. DEEP approved 440 additional carp. Not given a permit yet to put in lake. Lower fence installed and approved by DEEP. Have drawn down of 12 inches while repair to dam is completed. Might interfere with Tyler Lakes Draw down. Lakes to communicate with Selectman's office

Dog Pond: No Report

West Side Pond: Simon stated that the approved permit has not been issued and at this late date will be continued next year. They seem to be getting a run around by state. Recommend they contact Senator Stephen Harding for assistance.

Tyler Lake: Treatment completed for year. Testing is underway. Discovered that DEEP NDDB and our Scientist met without our presents. NDDB is using 20-year-old data even though they require undated info on a yearly basis. Planning on meeting jointly to discuss our situation.

Other: Mark had a discussion with FIU invasive plant people at the airport. They are here to consult with DEEP on the invasive plant

Hydrilla.. This is found as close to use as Twin Lakes. Every lake with a state boat launch is potentially at risk. The goods news is that Percell-A-Core will work on Hydrilla at proper dosage. Their concern is getting NDDB to approve the proper dosage
