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Meeting called to order at 7:01 pm.

Minutes of April 30, 2024. A motion to approve by Simon Ellis and 2nd by Chris Kennavane and approved.

Woodridge Lake: Chris stated that the weeds are back. The number of carp is down as a result of high water flowing over blockade. Request from DEEP for 400 additional carp to help control their weeds. DEEP reminded Woodridge about Lake Candlewood's problem and will come out at their convenience to inspect and evaluate. They inspect all boats and trailers entering the lake. As a private lake they can do this.

Dog Pond: They just completed hydro-raking on the north end and the results are great. It took 3 days and they wanted another couple of days but Northwest Aquatics was booked. Question on Town Grant for this year, they were informed that it is in the budget for tonight's Town Meeting.

West Side Pond: Simon stated that the approved permit has not been issued and at this late date will be continued next year. Curley Leaf problem has continued to expand and beyond their ability to control by hand pulling. They do have additional applications into DEEP for

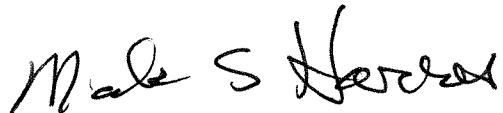
different treatments for Curley Leaf. Water quality is good and Simon enjoyed his early swim.

Tyler Lake: Marty Harris state that the first treatment has been completed and 2nd is scheduled for this week. NDDDB stipulated that all permitted treatments must be completed by June 1st. It was discovered that NDDDB is currently using a very old map listing species that have not been in the lake for 30 years. We do send them updated survey every year but the are not using those even though they require the survey from us. Not happy with George having a meeting with DEEP and not informing us nor inviting us to attend.
