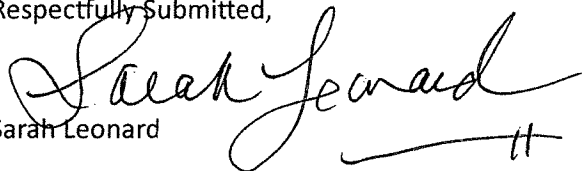

Call to order: Nanci Howard called the meeting to order at 7:04pm.

Attendance: Nanci Howard, Sue Breakell, Sarah Leonard, Erin Reilly (Recreation Director), Anne Craig, all present via zoom. Excused: Kim Andrusia & Lori Clinton

Secretary's Report: Special meeting minutes from December 22nd 2025 were the subject of the Secretary's Report. *Anne Craig made a motion to accept the minutes as presented; Sue Breakell seconded the motion. No discussion, Motion carried without issue.*

Financial Report: The Town Hall offices were not open today due to a snow storm; Budget vs Actual report did not get printed. Nothing out of the ordinary going on within our budget, Erin reported. *Anne Craig made a motion to accept the information provided by Erin within the Financial Report, Sue Breakell seconded, motion carried without discussion.*

Programming Report: *Kids Programs:* 59 children are signed up through Goshen Rec for the Mohawk Mountain program currently. Basketball program with Warren Morris and Litchfield continues on Saturdays, Erin obtained volunteers for the kindergarten kids, which is highly beneficial. Baking program with Mrs. Krukar on the horizon, Easter planning ongoing, Easter program will be on March 28th. Parent/Tots program potentially starting up again, Erin has had some inquiries regarding it.

Adult Programs: Yogas still occurring, Erin is trying to boost the Thursday Yoga again in the upcoming month of February, basketball and volleyball activities currently ongoing in the evenings at Goshen Center gym.

60+ Programs: Senior socials going well in collaboration with Goshen Community Care, Lunch bunch got cancelled due to low attendance this month, next senior trip is potentially February 23rd, also February 19th is the Flower and Garden show bus trip, a possible sock hop dance with 50 and 60s music may be in the works for a future date.

Family Community Programs: 40 people for the 'potato party', very well attended. Next brunch is on Valentines Day, February 14th. Craft fair February 7th at Camp Coch - there are a few more spots available. Community grief support gathering this week Jan 19th, upcoming - March 14th possible corn beef dinner!

Other Programming Items: Boating Safety course for 2026 will be in April, two week day nights, the 7th and 9th. Obedience dog training every Sunday in March & large animal care 'three day' course on sheep, goats and cattle at Camp Coch February 15th, 22nd and March 7th, programs will be available on our website. Cornwall also offered Goshen to participate in their curling program, available to individuals 12 years and up.
