Who May Vote By Absentee Ballot

Any qualified registered voter unable to vote in person.

How To Apply

Applications for Absentee Ballots can be obtained from the **Town Clerk**, or at the Secretary of the State's website.

Any qualified voter already out of town may have an application mailed to them. However, you **MUST** allow sufficient time for mailing and returning the application AND the ballot.

You may also apply on line at: myvote.ct.gov/getmyab to request an on-line Absentee Ballot. Please note not everyone will be able to use the o-line absentee ballot system.
