Review Department Requests

Public Works

Raz Alexe had proposed postponing the Constitution Way project (\$118,880) until 2025/26. He also proposed reducing the Old South Road project to \$80,000 and pushing the balance (\$488,793) to 25/26. Under Facilities, the \$115,448 for EV chargers was deleted. This total reduction of \$723,121 in the Public Works budget takes the total request from \$2,423,488 to \$1,700,367. **Motion:** S. Fogarty moved to amend the Public Works total capital budget request to \$1,700,367. J. Morosani seconded, all voted aye and the motion passed.

Park and Recreation

Everyone seemed happy with the proposed projects. **Motion:** S. Fogarty moved and J. Morosani seconded a motion to approve the amount of \$495,725 for the three projects in Park and Recreation. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

Board of Fire & EMS

- E. Marriott felt the proposal was reasonable, and there were a few clarifications from S. Fogarty. Motion:
- J. Morosani moved to approve the Board of Fire & EMS budget request of \$237,808, and M. Kostecki seconded. All voted aye and the motion carried.

Finalize and Recommend

Motion: M. Kostecki moved and J. Morosani seconded a motion to approve \$2,433,900 for this year's total capital request. All voted aye and the motion carried.
