Review Open Space documents from P&Z and Subdivision regs and the POCAD Commissioner Putnam commented on the town subdivision planning in particular Section 7 of the Subdivision Regulations.

Commissioner Reed presented information from the town's POCAD concerning Open Space and Land Use. Commissioner Putnam remarked that we need to get familiar with the town's open space provisions in the Zoning and Subdivision Regulations, as well as the current POCAD; she will send links to the POCAD, Open Space Policy and the Zoning and Subdivision regulations.

There was discussion about the difference between preserved open space and undeveloped land. Commissioner Fowler will ask Stacey Deming of the Housatonic Valley Association for the percentages of protected and unprotected Open Space in Litchfield. (White Memorial Foundation land is undeveloped, but not protected. The Foundation has given away or sold land to the Community Center, State Police Barracks and the Lakeview High School.)

Enforcement of Conservation easements: We need a list of the land we own easements on.
