- Budget meeting at Town Hall. Tara and Shellayne are tasked to deal with this. The Town
 only gives the EDC \$1000. We need to lobby the BOD for \$\$. The appeal could include a
 paid staff person. We have spent approx. \$20,000, raising \$\$ through sponsorships/guide
 and grants, and merchandising.
- Scherr-Thoss grant was completely used to build our digital presence.
- Strong appeal to the Town to be funding the Content Marketing expert in Doug.
- AARPA \$30,000.00 we only spent \$3000 of that. By the end of 2024 our balance will be \$12,000. **We need a financial roadmap person, Shellayne....**to prepare for grant cycles; when is the operating budget meeting happening, etc, to ask for what we need.
- Are we allowed to sell Litchfield Merchandise? How do we collect revenue? Someone needs to research this. Michele offered to research.
- "The process of opening a business in Litchfield", page on the website. Missy will research.
- Kitu from SMART COMM. To achieve Gold Standard, they must create a data base of businesses, the EDC can work with Kitu/SMART.
- Create a survey for businesses.
- Tara will circulate the schedule for next years meeting.
